### 16.2 Second Opinions

When it is necessary to refer a case for a second, specialist opinion an interim report will be issued which will include the name and location of the reviewing Consultant.

The majority of cases are referred to specialists from within our Network Pathology Group. Occasionally it is necessary to refer cases to other specialists.
